



# Procrypt Product Data Sheet



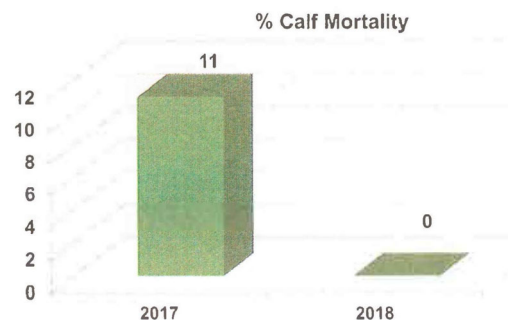
Like other ranchers in South Dakota, Delbert Fast has fought early calf mortality caused by cryptosporidiosis (crypto) every spring. For several years, calves started scouring at 7 to 10 days of age with up to 50% of his calf crop being affected. Calves were treated individually with electrolytes to prevent dehydration and even with treatment, he lost 25 of 225 calves in 2017. The diagnosis was confirmed as crypto with a laboratory submission by veterinarian Dr. Murray Ketteler.

"I tried everything available, but crypto just continued to cost me lots of money

with lost calves, treatment products and labor", Delbert reports. So, when presented with an opportunity to trial a new product, Procrypt, he felt he had nothing to lose. A program was put together with a protein mineral formulation containing Procrypt fed free choice (intended dosage was 10 to 15 grams of Procrypt per day per head). Delbert started feeding in early December before his calving season started on March 20, 2018.

Delbert calculates that by decreasing mortality by three calves, he will have paid for the treatment of his entire 225 cow herd. Additional benefits include the improved performance (and profit) of healthier calves at weaning and reduced cost of labor and treatment products.
